ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA: -
Candidate should be a citizen of India.
AGE LIMIT:
Candidates should have completed the age of Seventeen years on or before 31st
December 2023. Evidence for the age (e.g., Birth Certificate, 10 th Mark Sheet, +2 Mark
sheet, etc.) should be produced.
EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS:
Candidates should have passed in all the subjects of the qualifying examination of the
Higher Secondary Certificate Examination conducted by the Tamil Nadu State Board or
any other equivalent Board in the following group of subjects along with English
individually.
(a) Physics, Chemistry, Botany and Zoology. (or)
(b) Physics, Chemistry, Biology with any other subject.
Note: Candidates who have passed in other board of examination (i.e., other than the
Tamil Nadu State Board, CBSE and ICS) with same subjects as mentioned above in
Clause 3 should produce the Eligibility Certificate from The Tamil Nadu Dr. MGR
Medical University before attending the Counselling.
Candidates who have passed the qualifying examinations from <i>National Institute of</i>
Open Schooling* or State Open Schools* or as private candidates* from recognized
State Boards; or with Biology/Biotechnology as an additional subject shall be allowed
but subject to the outcome of Special Leave Petitions/ Appeals filed by the Medical
Council of India. (On par with other AYUSH Courses)
Note: *"The proviso in italics has been a subject matter of challenge before the Hon'ble
High Court of Delhi, Hon'ble High Court of Allahabad, Lucknow Bench, and Hon'ble
High Court of Madhya Pradesh at Jabalpur. The provisions of the regulations
disqualifying recognized Open School Board candidates and the candidates who have
studied Biology/Biotechnology as an Additional Subject has been struck down."

4. **ELIGIBILITY FOR MINORITY SEATS:**

- 1. The Candidates who are eligible to claim Linguistic Minority Seats reflecting their mother tongue should produce the Study Certificate issued by the Head of the Institution last studied Annexure I or a certificate issued by the Competant revenue authority of the candidate's native jurisdiction Annexure VI (b).
- 2. The Candidates who are eligible to claim Religious Minority seats / Linguistic Minority seats, which is a NOTIFIED MINORITY COMMUNITY AS PER Section 2(c) of National Commission for Minorities Act, 1992 should produce the Study Certificate issued by the Head of the Institution last studied Annexure VI (a) or a certificate issued by the competent revenue authority of the candidate's native jurisdiction Annexure I A. The Candidates submitting these Annexures in full form alone will be given preference in Minority Colleges as per their Minority Status.
- 5. The following categories of candidates are NOT ELIGIBLE to apply for B.N.Y.S. Course.
- a. Candidates who have passed H.Sc. in Vocational Stream, Pre-University Course in Tamil Nadu, and who used scribe, who did not study English as a subject in higher secondary examination.
- b. Candidates presently pursuing the B.N.Y.S. Course are **NOT ELIGIBLE** to apply during this academic session.
- c. The selection and admission of candidates of other than those in Clause 3 will be provisional subject to recognition of the qualifying examination by the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University under which the candidate gets admitted. In case, the recognition is not accorded for the admission of the candidate on any grounds, the provisional admission will not entitle the candidate for the continuance of the course and the admission will be stands cancelled.

8. **DURATION OF THE BNYS COURSE:**

The duration of BNYS course is five and half years including one year of Compulsory Rotatory Residential Internship.

9. DETERMINATIONS OF RANK OF THE CANDIDATES:

a. Ranking will be made by merit on the basis of marks obtained by the eligible candidates in the prescribed science subjects in the qualifying examinations reduced to the base of 200 marks. The marks obtained through different Boards of Examination will be taken into account after normalization of marks.

b. Ranking of the candidates will be done based on the total marks obtained in the relevant science subjects after normalization of marks computed to a maximum of 200, as mentioned above.

c. Normalization of Marks:

i.) The marks obtained by the students in the relevant subjects in the qualifying examination conducted by various Boards or Authority will be equated with the marks obtained by the students in the same subjects in the qualifying examination conducted by the State Board of Tamil Nadu by adopting the method of normalization.

Explanation: - Under the method of normalization, the highest mark obtained by the students of various Boards in each subject will be equated to the highest mark obtained by the students of State Board in that subject and the relative marks obtained by other students in that subject will be determined accordingly.

	Illustration : - If the highest mark secured by the student of State Board in Physics is 100,
	and the highest mark secured by the student of any other Board in the same subject is 90,
	both the highest mark will be considered to be equal to 100. If the student of the Other
	Board secures 60 marks in Physics when the highest mark in Physics in the same board is
	90, the 60 marks will be considered to be equal to 66.66 marks as arrived at below: -
	$100 \times 60/90 = 66.66\%$
	ii) After normalization of marks in the relevant subjects in the qualifying examination
	conducted by different Boards, the qualified students of different Boards will be merged
	into a common merit list.
d.	Determination of Rank of Candidates Obtaining Equal Marks (Inter Se Merit):
	In cases, where two or more candidates obtain equal aggregated marks for 200, the rank
	of such candidates shall be determined on the basis of the following order, namely: -

10.	The merit list will be published on the notice board at the office of the Selection
	Committee and will be posted simultaneously on the website: www.tnhealth.tn.gov.in
11.	The selection will be made by counselling based on the merit only.
12.	All selections and admissions to BNYS course are only provisional. The selection and
	admission are liable to be cancelled at any time as and when the eligibility conditions
	are found to be defective or incorrect or of any suppression of facts deliberately or
	otherwise. The right of allotment to BNYS Course and College is vested totally with the
	Selection Committee.
13.	COUNSELLING:
	Selection of candidates will be done through counselling based on the merit.

a) Selection committee is the designated authority for counselling for admissions to i. BNYS course in all Government and Self-Financing Yoga and Naturopathy Medical Colleges in Tamil Nadu. b) No authority or institution shall admit any candidate to the undergraduate course in contravention of the criteria or procedure as laid down by Selection committee in respect of admissions and any candidate admitted in contravention of the said criteria or procedure shall be discharged. Counselling Schedule will be made available on the website (www.tnhealth.tn.gov.in). ii. Candidates can attend the counselling session based on their merit. iii. a) All Communication regarding Counselling will be displayed / available through the official website only and any change or modification and relevant information pertaining to this admission process will be made available on the website www.tnhealth.tn.gov.in b) The candidates are instructed to visit the website at least two times a day for updates from the date of issue of application till the end of admission process without fail. Selection Committee will not be responsible for consequences resulting due to nondiligent follow-up of notices, notification and publications appearing on the website regarding admission to B.N.Y.S. Course 2023-2024 Session. c) Candidates should attend the Counselling session as per the Schedule and as per their rank mentioned in official website: www.tnhealth.tn.gov.in. One of the Parents or Guardian will be allowed to accompany the candidate to attend the iv. counselling and they should make their own arrangements for attending the counselling session. Selection will be made by counselling based on merit. Candidates can select a v. college of their own choice at the time of counseling. However, the allotment is subject to availability of the seats. 	another college based on merit. If a candidate gives option to stay in the previously
	allotted college, he/she is allowed to opt out of the movement procedure by giving a
	declaration for the same and they will not be considered for change of college at a later

Note:

- Candidates who fails to attend the Counselling schedule stipulated to them, as
 per their turn, for whatsoever reasons, will be given a seat in the existing
 vacancies available in any one of the colleges irrespective of their merit of marks,
 within the same phase of Counselling.
- 2. Candidates getting allotment through court orders before the cutoff date will be given a seat in the existing vacancies under management quota available at the time of counseling when he/she actually attends.
- 3. Candidates who fail to attend the counselling at the specified date and time will forfeit their right to admission and their names will not be considered at later phase of Counselling. However, he/she can authorize his/her parent on his/her behalf for that phase of counseling due to any unavoidable circumstances. The parents' decision will be binding on the candidate. An authorization letter given by the candidate should be submitted by the parents along with the original documents of any one of the identification proofs such as Voter ID, driving license, Pan Card, Passport, Aadhar card, etc. of both the parent and the candidate as mentioned in the annexure II and II (A). Due to unforeseen and unavoidable circumstances, if a candidate, his/her parents/guardian could not attend the counseling on the specified date and time, the candidate will be permitted to attend the counseling on the subsequent date in the same phase of counseling and he/she can only opt for the seats available at the time of counseling and cannot claim seat as per his/her rank.
- 4. Those who do not join within the stipulated time to the particular college to which they are allotted, will not be considered for admission at any point of time later under management quota.
- 5. No candidate can opt to be waitlisted for a particular college when seats are available in other colleges at his/ her turn.
- 6. If a candidate opts out of (not willing to take) when seats are available at the time of his / her counselling, then he/she will not be eligible for the same seat at any point of time later for whatsoever reason.
- 7. Individual request for transfer of college will not be entertained after allotment of seat is made.
- 8. Mutual transfers will not be entertained under any circumstances.

- 17. All the entries in the application form should be written legibly by the candidate in his/her own handwriting. The candidate should ensure that all information including the marks in the qualifying examination furnished by him/her in the application and the enclosure are correct. The candidate is informed that after scrutiny of his/her application, it is found that the marks furnished by him/her in the application are not correct or any other information is found to be incorrect, then;
- a. He / She will forfeit the admission no matter at what stage of the course he/she will be at that time;

b. He / She will be debarred from pursuing any studies for a period of three years; Legal action will be initiated against the candidate and the parents for furnishing incorrect C. information; Criminal action will be instituted against him/her for furnishing false documents. d. 18. The documents enclosed along with the application will not be returned. Candidates are required to enclose ONLY One set of Self - attested Photo copies of the following certificates as in the check list along with the application. 19. The selection and admission of candidates of other Universities / Boards will be provisional subject to recognition of the qualifying examination by The Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University under which the candidate gets admitted. In case, the recognition is not accorded for the admission of the candidate on any ground, the provisional admission will not entitle the candidate right for the continuance of the course and the admission will stand cancelled. 20. The Selected Candidates should produce all the original documents at the time of admission to the Principal of the Medical College concerned. Selection / Allotment will stand cancelled if the candidates could not produce the original documents at the time of admission. 21. Selected candidates should produce a physical fitness certificate obtained from a Registered Medical Practitioner not below the rank of Assistant Surgeon or "A" Class practitioner Registered with Tamil Nadu Board of Indian Medicine or Tamil Nadu Siddha Medical Council or Tamil Nadu Homoeopathy Medical Council, Chennai at the time of joining the course. 22. **DISCONTINUATION FEES:** i) Candidates selected for admission and his/her parent /guardian will have to execute an Agreement Bond as prescribed in Appendix–II. Failure to execute the Agreement Bond will lead to cancellation of selection. ii) Candidates who discontinue the course on or after the last cut off date for admission process for the academic session 2023 - 2024 and on any date of the subsequent year are bound by the bond and thereby they shall have to pay a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One lakh only) as penalty for having breached the contract in the bond by means of Demand Draft drawn in favour of "The Director of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy, Chennai-106" payable at Chennai.

	Note: This penalty is only for candidates who discontinue the course and not for those Candidates who seek re-allotment and movement from one to another College.
23.	Candidates selected for admission and his / her parent / guardian will have to sign discipline declaration form in Annexure – III and failure to sign the declaration will result in the cancellation of selection.
24.	Candidates can type the necessary certificates in the prescribed format separately and attach the same along with application.
25.	Candidates selected for admission to BNYS Course are not guaranteed any appointment in Government Service.
26.	Hepatitis-B vaccination: All candidates selected for admission to first year BNYS course should take the Hepatitis-B Vaccine before admission to the Course and only on producing a certificate in Annexure – VI, the Principals will admit the candidates. The students should take further doses at the prescribed intervals as required.
27.	In respect of selected candidate's adequate original documentary evidence shall be required and verification may also be done to decide on their eligibility under various categories.
28.	Enquiry or any correspondence regarding the selection of candidates will not be entertained.
29.	The Candidates who join BNYS Course should not indulge or participate in any kind of ragging. If they are found to have indulged in ragging in past or noticed later, the candidates will be removed from roll of institution at whatever stage of study and criminal action will be taken against candidates.
30.	If proof of Authenticity of Certificate could not be obtained by the Institution on time, the candidate will not be allowed to continue the 2 nd year of study.
